Professional Certificates

Passed the Certificate of Asian Institute of Insurance (CAii); **OR**



International Recognition

Passed Certificate in Insurance from The Chartered Insurance Institute (CII), United Kingdom (certified true copy required)



AAii Level 2 Entry Requirements:

Must have obtained AAii Level 1 before progressing to Level 2

Important Note: Students with recognised relevant qualifications can receive credit exemptions. Exemption applications are subject to evaluation by Aii's selection committee on a case-by-case basis.
