Raymond Tang Main Speaker

Raymond Tang was the CEO of Eastspring Investment Bhd (EIB), the investment arm of Prudential plc, from 2016 until his retirement in 2024. He had overall responsibility of the Malaysian business of Eastspring Group.

Before joining EIB, he was the Regional CIO, ASEAN and Head of Institutional and International Business in CIMB-Principal Asset Management (now Principal Asset Management) from 2004 to 2016. He managed an ASEAN investment team. Prior to joining CIMB, Raymond was the CEO/CIO of CMS Dresdner Asset Management from 1996 to 2004 and was attached with SBB Asset Management before that.

Raymond is very involved in industry development, engaging regulators as the industry's voice as well as serving in various committees with regulators. He served as:

- Chairman of the Malaysian Association of Asset Managers, from 2008 to 2022
- Chairman of the FTSE Bursa Index Committee, overseeing index development for Bursa from 2010 to 2019 and Index Advisory Panel, from 2019 to 2023
- Committee Member, Members Participating Committee, Bursa Malaysia, from 2016 to 2020
- Committee Member, Listing Committee, Bursa Malaysia, from 2021 to present
- Committee Member, Financial Markets Committee in Bank Negara Malaysia, from 2017 to 2024
- Committee Member, Institutional Investors' Council, from 2021 to 2024
- Committee Member, Fund Management Digitization Group (FMDG) of Securities Commission, from 2019 to 2024
- Chairman of FMDG sub-committee Services Working Group, from 2019 to 2024
- Board Member of Securities Industry Dispute Resolution Center (SIDREC), from 2010 to 2020
- Invitee to Malaysian Islamic Financial Center (MIFC) on development of Islamic Finance for Malaysia
