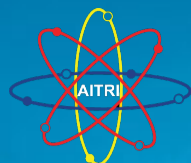

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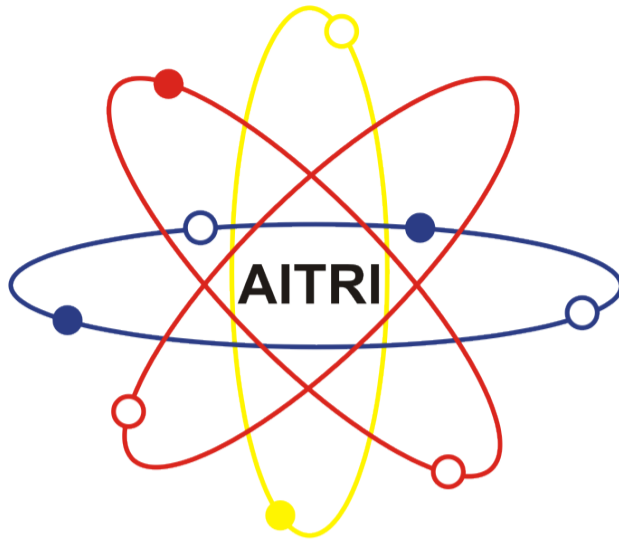

AITRI



The **ASEAN Insurance Training and Research Institute (AITRI)** was established in September 2000, during the ASEAN Insurance Regulators Meeting, as part of the region's efforts to restore confidence, regenerate economic growth and promote regional financial stability.

AITRI was officially incorporated on 1st December 2004. The Malaysian Insurance Institute (MII), now known as Asian Institute of Insurance (Aii), was mandated as the Secretariat and AITRI headquarters is now based in the Asian Institute of Chartered Bankers (AICB) building in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. Registered in Malaysia, AITRI has been receiving strong support from the Central Bank of Malaysia (Bank Negara Malaysia) since its inception. To ensure the involvement of each member, the insurance supervisor of the member countries was appointed to be the members of the AITRI Board of Trustees.

AITRI aims to be the leading Insurance Training and Research Institute in the ASEAN region, championing advancements in regulatory frameworks, innovation, and sustainability. Its mission is to:

- Spearhead the ASEAN Insurance Intellectual Capital Development
- Provide human capacity building programmes in insurance for ASEAN
- Provide efficient and effective learning and research infrastructure
- Serve and facilitate the needs for development in education, training and research for the Regulators, insurers, intermediaries and consumers of ASEAN members to help support the development of the ASEAN insurance markets



The **ASEAN Insurance Council (AIC)** was formed in 1978 to foster regional cooperation within the private sector insurance industry across various ASEAN countries, embodying the spirit of friendship and cooperation outlined in the ASEAN Declaration of 1967. In 1983, the AIC became an officially accredited entity, gaining formal status as an ASEAN Non-Governmental Organization (NGO).

Representation at the AIC encompasses 15 member associations from ASEAN Member States alongside three affiliated member associations. Currently, the participating ASEAN nations include Brunei Darussalam, Cambodia, Indonesia, Lao PDR, Malaysia, Myanmar, the Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, and Vietnam.

The AIC serves as the primary regional platform for industry leaders to network, share expertise, and collaborate with external partners and insurance regulators. Furthermore, through annual joint plenary sessions with the ASEAN Insurance Regulators' Meeting (AIRM), the AIC actively facilitates collaboration on regulatory developments to strengthen and unify the industry.
